



- Whole-Class Discussion and Debate



STUDENT WRITINGwith Reference to the Text



- Writing Process (pre-write, revision, final draft)
- Graphic Organizers
- Model and circulate
- Share and analyze exemplar student work
- Peer evaluations

TIPS:

Focus on one trait/feature at a time.

Assign and grade only 1-3 paragraphs with limited comments and time for revision. Have regularly scheduled "writing days" - circulate & evaluate while students work.

Ideas

- Knowledge of topic
- Narrowed topic
 Stays on topic; focused
- · Ideas make sense; clarity
- · Ideas elaborated & developed



Organization

- Prewriting
- · Beginning, middle, end
- Logical order/sequence
- Transitions



Voice

- Reader–writer connection
- Sense of audience
- Writer's attitude about the topic
- · Point of view



Word Choice

- Specific words, rather than general & vague (Right word, right spot)
- · "Wow" words; "Purple" words
- Synonyms
- Vivid sensory descriptions/imagery
- Strong action verbs



Sentence Fluency

- Complete sentences
- Easy to read aloud
- Varied sentences
- (beginnings, lengths, types, etc.)
 Figurative language helps the piece sound rhythmic & musical




